Section 11. Section 631.65, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

631.65 Prohibited advertisement or solicitation.—No person shall make, publish, disseminate, circulate, or place before the public, or cause, directly or indirectly, to be made, published, disseminated, circulated, or placed before the public, in a

12 newspaper, magazine, or other publication, or in the form of a
13 notice, circular, pamphlet, letter, or poster, or over any radio
14 station or television station, or in any other way, any
15 advertisement, announcement, or statement which uses the
16 existence of the insurance guaranty association for the purpose
17 of sales, solicitation, or inducement to purchase any form of
18 insurance covered under this part. However, this section does
19 not prohibit a duly licensed insurance agent from explaining the
20 existence or function of the insurance guaranty association to
21 policyholders, prospects, or applicants for coverage.
