Section 4. Paragraph (h) of subsection (2) of section 379.353, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

379.353 Recreational licenses and permits; exemptions from fees and requirements.--

(2) A hunting, freshwater fishing, or saltwater fishing license or permit is not required for:

(h) Any resident saltwater fishing from land or from a structure fixed to the land, or any person who has been determined eligible for the food stamp, temporary cash assistance, or Medicaid programs by the Department of Children and Family Services. A benefit issuance or program identification card issued by the Department of Children and
