A bill to be entitled

An act relating to commercial motor vehicles; amending s. 316.535, F.S.; increasing the maximum weight limits on certain vehicles to compensate for weight increases that result from the installation of idle-reduction technologies; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Present subsections (3), (4), (5), (6), (7), and (8) of section 316.535, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (4), (5), (6), (7), (8), and (9), respectively, a new subsection (3) is added to that section, and present subsection (8) of that section is amended, to read:

316.535 Maximum weights.-

(3) (a) The maximum gross vehicle weight and the axle weight limit for any commercial motor vehicle equipped with idle-reduction technologies shall be increased by a amount, not to exceed 400 pounds, which is necessary to compensate for the additional weight of the idle-reduction technologies.

(b) Upon the request of a regulatory agency or law enforcement agency, a vehicle operator shall provide proof through demonstration or certification that:

1. The idle-reduction technologies on the vehicle are fully functional at all times; and

 $\underline{\text{2. The 400-pound gross weight increase is not used for any}}$  purpose other than the idle-reduction technologies.

(8) Except as otherwise hereinafter provided in this section, a no vehicle or combination of vehicles exceeding the
