370 license plate, a person must submit a certified letter from the
371 Florida State Lodge of the Fraternal Order of Police showing
372 that he or she qualifies for the use of the Fraternal Order of
373 Police law enforcement emblem by being a member in good
374 standing.

375 (c) The license plate annual use fees shall be distributed
376 to the Florida State Lodge Fraternal Order of Police Memorial
377 Foundation to fund its activities, programs, and projects aimed
