An act relating to specialty license plates; amending ss. 320.08056 and 320.08058 , F.S.; creating the Children First license plate; establishing an annual use fee for the plate; providing for the distribution of use fees received from the sale of such plates; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (qqq) is added to subsection (4) of section 320.08056 , Florida Statutes, to read:
320.08056 Specialty license plates.-
(4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:
(qqq) Children First license plate, $\$ 25$.
Section 2. Subsection (69) is added to section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:
320.08058 Specialty license plates.-
(69) CHILDREN FIRST LICENSE PLATES.-
(a) The department shall develop a Children First license plate as provided in this section. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate and the words "Children First" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to Children First Florida, Inc., which shall retain all proceeds until the startup costs to develop and establish the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the proceeds shall be used as follows:

1. A maximum of 15 percent of the proceeds may be used to
administer the license plate program and for direct
administrative costs associated with the operations of Children
First Florida, Inc.
2. A maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds may be used to promote and market the license plates.
3. The remaining fees shall be used by Children First Florida, Inc., to fund public schools in this state, including teacher salaries.
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
