insert:

Section 25. (1) Upon completion of the project to develop passive strategies for nitrogen reduction which complement the use of conventional onsite wastewater treatment systems, as provided in Specific Appropriation 1682 of the General Appropriations Act of 2008-2009, the Department of Health shall submit a final report to the Executive Office of the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

13 (2) Notwithstanding s. 369.318(2), Florida Statutes, the
14 Department of Health shall suspend rulemaking to achieve
15 nitrogen reductions that are protective of groundwater quality
16 within the Springs Study Area until the project is completed.
17 The department shall resume rulemaking for such purpose upon the
18 adjournment sine die of the next regular session of the
19 Legislature beginning after the department submits the project's
20 final report.
