The Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation
(Constantine) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment to Amendment (768904)

Between lines 88 and 89
insert:

(2) The department is directed to adopt rules to implement the requirements of this section. Such rules at a minimum shall:

(a) Create a priority list of first and second magnitude springs designating them as high, medium, or low priority based on the following measurements of nitrate at the spring boil as an average annual concentration:

1. High - nitrate greater than or equal to 1.0mg/L;

12 2. Medium - nitrate greater than or equal to 0.5mg/L and
13 less than 1.0mg/L; and

14 3. Low - nitrate up to 0.5mg/L.

15 (b) Based on the priority determination of the department
16 for first and second magnitude springs, the corresponding
17 deadlines apply to the requirements of s. 369.405 to spring
18 protection zones as designated in this section.

19 1. For high priority springs, the deadline for compliance
20 shall be no later than July 1, 2016;

21 2. For medium priority springs, the deadline for compliance
22 shall be no later than July 1, 2019; and

23 3. For low priority springs, the deadline for compliance
24 shall be no later than July 1, 2024.
