Delete line 99
and insert:
optometric practice. The oral ocular pharmaceutical agents that may be placed on the formulary for use by a certified optometrist are limited to the following categories: analgesics; antibacterial; anti-inflammatory; anti-allergy; antiviral; and anti-glaucoma. Oral anti-glaucoma osmotic agents may be placed on the formulary for use by a certified optometrist only in the case of a patient emergency. Oral antifungal agents may not be
