 $\frac{4.(d)}{(d)}$ Collect, receive, manage, and dispose of and make elections regarding the proceeds from a life insurance policy or annuity contract payable to, or otherwise accruing to the benefit of, the child; and

5. (e) Collect, receive, manage, dispose of, and make elections regarding the proceeds of any benefit plan as defined by s. 710.102, of which the minor is a beneficiary, participant, or owner,

without appointment, authority, or bond, when the amounts received, in the aggregate, do not exceed \$15,000.

(b) In addition to the authority granted in paragraph (a), natural guardians are authorized, on behalf of any of their minor children, to waive and release, in advance, any claim or cause of action that would accrue to any of their minor children to the same extent that any adult may do so on his or her own behalf. Waivers and releases under this paragraph are disfavored and must be strictly construed against a party claiming to be relieved of liability due to such a waiver and release. Such waivers and releases are enforceable only where and to the extent that the intention to be relieved of liability was made clear and unequivocal in the waiver and release and the wording of the waiver and release was so clear and understandable that an ordinary and knowledgeable person would know what he or she would be contracting away. Nothing in this paragraph shall be construed to allow such a waiver and release for illegal acts.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
