(c) If a traffic citation is issued under s. 316.0083 and the violation occurred in the unincorporated portion of a county which has divided the function of clerk between the clerk of the circuit court and the county comptroller who serves as ex officio clerk of the board of county commissioners, recorder, auditor, and custodian of all county funds and official records, the traffic infraction officer shall provide a replica of the

citation to the county comptroller within 5 days after the date of issuance of the citation to the violator.

Section 8. Subsection (2) of section 318.14, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

318.14 Noncriminal traffic infractions; exception; procedures.-

(2) Except as provided in s. 316.1001(2) and s. 316.0083(3), any person cited for an infraction under this section must sign and accept a citation indicating a promise to appear. The officer may indicate on the traffic citation the time and location of the scheduled hearing and must indicate the applicable civil penalty established in s. 318.18.

Section 9. Subsection (15) of section 318.18, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

318.18 Amount of penalties. - The penalties required for a noncriminal disposition pursuant to s. 318.14 or a criminal offense listed in s. 318.17 are as follows:

- (15) (a) One hundred fifty twenty-five dollars for a violation of s. 316.074(1) or s. 316.075(1)(c)1. when a driver has failed to stop at a traffic signal and when enforced by a law enforcement officer. Sixty dollars shall be distributed as provided in s. 318.21, \$25 shall be distributed to the General Revenue Fund, and the remaining \$65 shall be remitted to the Department of Revenue for deposit into the Administrative Trust Fund of the Department of Health.
- (b) One hundred fifty dollars for a violation of s. 316.074(1) or s. 316.075(1)(c)1. when a driver has failed to stop at a traffic signal and when enforced by the department's traffic infraction enforcement officer shall be distributed to



the General Revenue Fund.

(c) One hundred fifty dollars for a violation of s. 316.074(1) or s. 316.075(1)(c)1. when a driver has failed to stop at a traffic signal and when enforced by a county or municipality's traffic infraction enforcement officer. Seventy dollars shall be distributed to the county or municipality issuing the citation, \$55 shall be distributed to the General Revenue Fund, and the remaining \$25 shall be remitted to the Department of Revenue for deposit into the Department of Health Administrative Trust Fund.
