The trust fund shall be administered by the department 20 and used to allocate funds to public county or municipal law 21 enforcement agencies to purchase and maintain technology 22 equipment to be used in their law enforcement activities. 23 Equipment that may be purchased and maintained with grants under 24 this section may include, but is not limited to, in-car cameras 25 and personal digital recorders to record encounters with 26 suspects. The fee collected for each offense shall be 27 distributed only to the law enforcement agency responsible for 28 the arrest for that offense.
