A bill to be entitled

An act relating to false reports of child abuse; amending s. 39.402, F.S.; requiring a child to be returned to a parent or guardian within 3 days following a determination that an order for shelter care was based on a false report of child abuse, abandonment, or neglect; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (13) of section 39.402, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

39.402 Placement in a shelter.-

(13) A child may not be held in a shelter under an order so directing for more than 60 days without an adjudication of dependency. A child may not be held in a shelter for more than 30 days after the entry of an order of adjudication unless an order of disposition has been entered by the court. A child may not be held in a shelter for more than 3 days following a determination that the order for shelter placement was based on a false report, in which case the child shall be returned to the custody of the parent or guardian.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
