WHEREAS, after a jury trial resulting in a verdict in favor of Madonna Castillo, the City of Hialeah initiated appellate proceedings, and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a settlement agreement, pursuant to which, on April 2, 2004, the City of Hialeah paid to Madonna Castillo and her mother, Reyna Castillo, the sum of \$100,000 apiece, for a grand total of \$200,000, and agreed to support a claim bill by the Legislature in the amount of \$50,000 in favor of Madonna Castillo, NOW, THEREFORE,
