Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (4) of section 390.01114, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

390.01114 Parental Notice of Abortion Act.-

- (4) PROCEDURE FOR JUDICIAL WAIVER OF NOTICE.
- (a) A minor may petition any circuit court in a judicial circuit within the jurisdiction of the District Court of Appeal in which she resides for a waiver of the notice requirements of subsection (3) and may participate in proceedings on her own behalf. The petition may be filed under a pseudonym or through the use of initials, as provided by court rule. The petition must include a statement that the petitioner is pregnant and notice has not been waived. The court shall advise the minor that she has a right to court-appointed counsel and shall provide her with counsel upon her request at no cost to the minor. A nonresident minor may not petition any circuit court of this state for a waiver of the notice requirements of subsection (3).

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
