A bill to be entitled An act relating to school bus stops; amending s. 1006.22, F.S.; prohibiting school bus stops from being located directly on certain state-maintained roads; providing for phased-in implementation; providing an effective date. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (12) of section 1006.22, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 1006.22 Safety and health of students being transported. -- Maximum regard for safety and adequate protection of health are primary requirements that must be observed by district school boards in routing buses, appointing drivers, and providing and operating equipment, in accordance with all requirements of law and rules of the State Board of Education in providing transportation pursuant to s. 1006.21: (12)(c)1. Each district school board shall establish school bus stops, or provide by district school board rule for the establishment of school bus stops, as necessary at the most reasonably safe locations available. Where unusual traffic hazards exist at school bus stops on roads maintained by the state outside of municipalities, the Department of Transportation, in concurrence and cooperation with and upon request of the district school board, shall place signs at such bus stops warning motorists of the location of the stops.
