Department of Business and Professional Regulation shall provide, contract, or approve services for the development, preparation, administration, scoring, score reporting, and evaluation of all examinations. The division shall seek the advice of the appropriate board in providing such services.

(a) The department, acting in conjunction with the Division of Service Operations Technology and the Division of Real Estate, as appropriate, shall ensure that examinations adequately and reliably measure an applicant's ability to practice the profession regulated by the department. After an examination developed or approved by the department has been administered, the board or department may reject any question which does not reliably measure the general areas of competency specified in the rules of the board or department, when there is no board. The department shall use professional testing services for the development, preparation, and evaluation of examinations, when such services are available and approved by the board.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
