 2 An act relating to a review under the Open Government
 3 Sunset Review Act regarding participants in government-
 4 sponsored recreation programs; amending s. 119.071, F.S.,
 5 which provides an exemption from public records
 6 requirements for information that would identify or locate
 7 a child who participates in a government-sponsored
 8 recreation program or a parent or guardian of the child;
 9 providing definitions; reorganizing the exemption; making
 10 editorial changes; repealing s. 2, ch. 2004-32, Laws of
 11 Florida, which provides for repeal of the exemption;
 12 providing an effective date.

 14 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 16 Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (5) of section
 17 119.071, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

18 119.071 General exemptions from inspection or copying of
 19 public records.--

20 (5) OTHER PERSONAL INFORMATION.--

21 (c) 1. For purposes of this paragraph, the term:

22 a. "Child" means any person younger than 18 years of age.

23 b. "Government-sponsored recreation program" means a
 24 program for which an agency assumes responsibility for a child
 25 participating in that program, including, but not limited to,
 26 after-school programs, athletic programs, nature programs,
 27 summer camps, or other recreational programs.

41 4. Information made exempt pursuant to this paragraph may
42 be disclosed by court order upon a showing of good cause.

43 5. This exemption applies to records held before, on, or
44 after the effective date of this exemption.

45 Section 2. Section 2 of chapter 2004-32, Laws of Florida,
46 is repealed.

47 Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
