 2           An act relating to a review under the Open Government  
 3           Sunset Review Act regarding participants in government-  
 4           sponsored recreation programs; amending s. 119.071, F.S.,  
 5           which provides an exemption from public records  
 6           requirements for information that would identify or locate  
 7           a child who participates in a government-sponsored  
 8           recreation program or a parent or guardian of the child;  
 9           providing definitions; reorganizing the exemption; making  
 10          editorial changes; removing superfluous language;  
 11          repealing s. 2, ch. 2004-32, Laws of Florida, which  
 12          provides for repeal of the exemption; providing an  
 13          effective date.

 15   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 17           Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (5) of section  
 18   119.071, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

19           119.071 General exemptions from inspection or copying of  
 20   public records.--

21           (5) OTHER PERSONAL INFORMATION.--

22           (c)1. For purposes of this paragraph, the term:

23           a. "Child" means any person younger than 18 years of age.

24           b. "Government-sponsored recreation program" means a  
 25 program for which an agency assumes responsibility for a child  
 26 participating in that program, including, but not limited to,  
 27 after-school programs, athletic programs, nature programs,  
 28 summer camps, or other recreational programs.

29        2. ~~Any~~ Information that would identify or ~~help to~~ locate a  
30 child who participates in a government-sponsored recreation  
31 program ~~programs or camps or the parents or guardians of such~~  
32 ~~child, including, but not limited to, the name, home address,~~

38        3. Information that would identify or locate a parent or  
39 guardian of a child who participates in a government-sponsored  
40 recreation program is exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a),  
41 Art. I of the State Constitution.

42        4. ~~Information made exempt pursuant to this paragraph may~~  
43 ~~be disclosed by court order upon a showing of good cause. This~~  
44 exemption applies to records held before, on, or after the  
45 effective date of this exemption.

46        Section 2. Section 2 of chapter 2004-32, Laws of Florida,  
47 is repealed.

48        Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
