Any Information that would identify or help to locate a child who participates in a government-sponsored recreation program programs or camps or the parents or guardians of such child, including, but not limited to, the name, home address, telephone number, social security number, or photograph of the child; the names and locations of schools attended by such child; and the names, home addresses, and social security numbers of parents or guardians of such child is exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.
- 3. Information that would identify or locate a parent or guardian of a child who participates in a government-sponsored recreation program is exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.
- 4. Information made exempt pursuant to this paragraph may be disclosed by court order upon a showing of good cause. This exemption applies to records held before, on, or after the effective date of this exemption.
- Section 2. <u>Section 2 of chapter 2004-32</u>, <u>Laws of Florida</u>, <u>is repealed</u>.
  - Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
