14   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

16          Section 1. Subsection (11) of section 125.901, Florida  
17          Statutes, is amended to read:

18          125.901 Children's services; independent special district;  
19          council; powers, duties, and functions; public records  
20          exemption.--

21          (11) ~~(a)~~ Personal identifying information of a child or the  
22          ~~child's~~ parent or guardian of the child, held by a council on  
23          children's services ~~service council~~, juvenile welfare board, or  
24          other similar entity created under this section or by special  
25          law, or held by a service provider or researcher under contract  
26          with such entity, is exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art.
