A bill to be entitled

An act relating to clerks of the circuit court; amending s. 28.12, F.S.; specifying authority of the clerk of the circuit court, as county auditor, to prepare financial statements and annual reports and conduct audits; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 28.12, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

28.12 Clerk of the board of county commissioners.—The clerk of the circuit court shall be clerk and accountant of the board of county commissioners. He or she shall keep the minutes and accounts and perform such other duties as provided by law. The clerk shall have custody of the seal and affix the same to any paper or instrument as required by law. When not otherwise provided by county charter or special law approved by a vote of the electors, the clerk of the circuit court, as county auditor, shall prepare the financial statements and the annual financial report of the county as required by s. 218.32 and may perform such audits, reviews, and tests of accounts maintained by the county as necessary to determine the adequacy of internal controls and compliance with contracts, applicable laws, and rules.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
