An act relating to traffic control; providing for the synchronization of traffic lights by the Department of Transportation and local traffic control authorities; providing for benchmarks and monitoring; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall, by January 1, 2012, synchronize the traffic lights on highways, roads, streets, and other transportation arteries that connect the focal points of traffic interest within its jurisdiction and the roads, streets, or other transportation arteries that have relatively high traffic volume compared with other traffic arteries within its jurisdiction.

- (2) The traffic control authority within each county and municipality shall, by January 1, 2012, synchronize the traffic lights on highways, roads, streets, or other transportation arteries that connect the focal points of traffic interest within the respective county or municipality and the roads, streets, or other transportation arteries that have relatively high traffic volume compared with other traffic arteries within the respective county or municipality.
- (3) The Department of Transportation shall establish performance benchmarks using best practices for traffic-light synchronization by the state, counties, and municipalities in order to optimize traffic flow under this act. The department
