**DELETE** the proviso immediately following Specific Appropriation 2568:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 2568, \$250,000 is provided to the Black Business Investment Board for operations and administration of the board, \$50,000 is provided to the Office of Tourism, Trade and Economic Development for the administration of the Black Business Loan Program, and \$2,450,000 is provided for the Black Business Loan Program.

Immediately following Specific Appropriation 2568, **INSERT:**

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 2568, \$350,000 is provided to the Black Business Investment Board for the operations and administration of the board, \$48,000 is provided to the Office of Tourism, Trade and Economic Development for the administration of the

**Black Business Loan Program, and \$2,352,000 is provided for the Black Business Loan Program.**

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
