At the end of existing proviso language, following Specific Appropriation 76, INSERT:

From funds provided for Instructional Materials in Specific Appropriations 5B and 76, \$175,000 is provided to the Florida Holocaust Museum to implement the statutory instructional mandate in section 1003.42(g), Florida Statutes.
