An act relating to the Florida False Claims Act; amending s. 68.086, F.S.; authorizing rather than requiring a court to award attorney's fees and expenses to a prevailing defendant under certain circumstances; providing applicability; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 68.086, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

68.086 Expenses; attorney's fees and costs.--

under this act and the <u>person bringing the action conducts the</u> action as provided in s. 68.083(6)(b) defendant is the <u>prevailing party</u>, the court <u>may shall</u> award <u>to</u> the defendant <u>his or her</u> reasonable attorney's fees and <u>expenses if the defendant prevails in costs against the person bringing the action and the court finds that the claim of the person bringing the action is clearly frivolous or vexatious or was brought primarily for purposes of harassment.</u>

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming law and shall apply to any pending or future action brought under the Florida False Claims Act or any action pending on appeal on or after the effective date of this act.
