11 communications organization, or, except for a political party or  
12 campaign of the candidate, any organization described under s.  
13 527 of the Internal Revenue Code, and may not control or  
14 coordinate or consult regarding the expenditure or raising of  
15 funds for any such committee or organization. Notwithstanding  
16 any other provision of this chapter, any person who knowingly  
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17 and willfully violates any provision of this paragraph commits a  
18 felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s.  
19 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
