A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program; amending s. 1009.53, F.S.; revising provisions relating to the refund by an educational institution to the Department of Education of funds received for courses dropped by students after the end of the drop and add period; providing an exception from the prohibition against the use of scholarship funds for certain courses; requiring a student's written appeal for such exception; amending s. 1009.532, F.S.; revising credit-hour requirements for renewal of a scholarship; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (5) of section 1009.53, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (11) is added to that section, to read:

1009.53 Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program. --

(5) The department shall issue awards from the scholarship program annually. Annual awards may be for up to 45 semester credit hours or the equivalent. Before the registration period each semester, the department shall transmit payment for each award to the president or director of the postsecondary education institution, or his or her representative, except that the department may withhold payment if the receiving institution fails to report or to make refunds to the department as required in this section.

(a) Within 30 days after the end of regular registration each semester, the educational institution shall certify to the department the eligibility status of each student who receives an award. After the end of the drop and add period, an institution is not required to reevaluate or revise a student's eligibility status; however, an institution but must make a refund to the department within 30 days after the end of the semester of any funds received for courses dropped by students after the end of the drop and add period unless a student has been granted an exception by the department pursuant to subsection (11) if a student who receives an award disbursement terminates enrollment for any reason during an academic term and a refund is permitted by the institution's refund policy.

(11) Funds for any scholarship within the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program may not be used to pay for courses dropped after the end of the drop and add period except as otherwise provided in this subsection. A student who receives an award under this program and subsequently drops one or more courses, or withdraws from all courses, after the end of the drop and add period due to verifiable illness or other emergency may be granted an exception from this prohibition against use of the scholarship funds unless the institution's policy is to refund the cost of the courses. The student must make a written appeal for such an exception to the institution. The appeal must include a description and verification of the circumstances.

Verification of illness or other emergency may include, but not be limited to, a physician's statement or the written statement of a parent or institution official. The institution shall

recommend exceptions with necessary documentation to the department. The department may accept or deny the institution's recommendations for exception.

Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 1009.532, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

- 1009.532 Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program; student eligibility requirements for renewal awards.--
- (1) To be eligible to renew a scholarship from any of the three types of scholarships under the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program, a student must:
- (a) Complete at least $\underline{24}$ $\underline{12}$ semester credit hours or the equivalent in the last academic year in which the student earned a scholarship <u>if the student was enrolled full time</u>, or a <u>prorated number of credit hours as determined by the Department of Education if the student was enrolled less than full time for any part of the academic year.</u>
 - Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
