(8) PENALTIES.—In addition to any other penalty provided in the Beverage Law, the division may suspend or revoke a winery shipper license or impose fines on the winery shipper licensee for any violation of this section.

(a) A winery shipper licensee that ships, or causes to be shipped, wine to any person in this state who is under 21 years of age commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as
