A bill to be entitled

An act relating to trust funds; creating the Statewide Mortgage Fraud Task Force Trust Fund within the Department of Legal Affairs; providing for the administration of the trust fund and use of moneys therein; requiring that balances of funds in the trust fund at the end of a fiscal year remain in the trust fund; providing for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

## Section 1. <u>Statewide Mortgage Fraud Task Force Trust</u> Fund.--

- (1) The Statewide Mortgage Fraud Task Force Trust Fund is created within the Department of Legal Affairs. Funds credited to the trust fund shall consist of revenues from appropriations allocated by the Legislature and federal grants. The trust fund shall be administered by the department and used to allocate funds to the Statewide Mortgage Fraud Task Force and the seven regional task forces. Activities subject to funding include developing and coordinating the implementation of the Statewide Mortgage Fraud Task Force, providing grants to law enforcement agencies in this state to conduct mortgage fraud investigations throughout the state, and providing grants to state attorneys offices for mortgage fraud prosecutions.
- (2) Notwithstanding s. 216.301, Florida Statutes, and pursuant to s. 216.351, Florida Statutes, any balance in the

trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund and be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.

(3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2013. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect on the same date as HB 733 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes law.
