## Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete lines 27 - 34 and insert:

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geographically suitable, and consistent with the requirements to assess real property at just value, the property appraiser may use image technology in lieu of physical inspection, and may review image technology, as the property appraiser deems  $\frac{1}{1}$  necessary, to ensure that the tax roll meets all the requirements of law. Regardless of the data-collection method



used, the property appraiser must collect and maintain on the assessment roll complete, accurate, and timely data on property characteristics to enable accurate and uniform just valuations required by ss. 192.042(1) and 193.085(1). Such data must be of sufficient quality, quantity, and timeliness to ensure compliance with all requirements of law for just valuations. During its in-depth reviews under s. 195.096 and consistent with s. 195.0012, the department is authorized to evaluate the completeness, accuracy, and timeliness of the data on property characteristics which a property appraiser collects and maintains on the assessment roll. Any such evaluations by the department may include, but are not limited to, a review of property size, condition, present use, and construction quality class. For its evaluations of the data on property characteristics maintained by the property appraiser, the department is authorized to conduct audits of the procedures used by a property appraiser pursuant to s. 195.096. However,
