An act relating to novelty lighters; prohibiting the sale or distribution of novelty lighters; providing a definition; providing an exception; providing

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

penalties; providing an effective date.

- Section 1. (1) Novelty lighters may not be sold at retail, given away, or otherwise distributed to anyone in this state.
- (2) As used in this section, the term "novelty lighter" means a mechanical device that uses a flammable gas or liquid or an electrical current to commonly ignite cigarettes, cigars, or pipes and that resembles any item that is typically appealing to children 10 years of age or younger, including, but not limited to, a lighter that resembles a cartoon character, animal, toy, gun, watch, musical instrument, vehicle, food, or beverage, that plays sounds or musical notes, or that displays flashing lights or other visual effects.
- (3) This section does not apply to lighters manufactured before January 1, 1980.
- (4) A first violation of this section is a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, Florida Statutes. A second or subsequent violation is a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, Florida Statues.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
