Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

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Section 1. Subsection (7) of section 443.036, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

443.036 Definitions.—As used in this chapter, the term:

(7) "Base period" means the first four of the last five completed calendar quarters immediately preceding the first day of an individual's benefit year. Wages in a base period used to

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establish a monetarily eligible benefit year may not be used to establish monetary eligibility in a subsequent benefit year.

(a) If information regarding wages for the calendar quarters immediately preceding the benefit year has not been entered into the Agency for Workforce Innovation's mainframe database from the regular quarterly reports of wage information submitted under s. 443.163 or is otherwise unavailable, the agency shall request the information from the employer by mail. The employer must provide the requested information within 10 days after the agency mails the request. An employer that fails to provide the requested wage information within the required time period is subject to the penalty for delinquent reports under s. 443.141.

(b) For a benefit year commencing on or after January 1, 2010, if an individual is not monetarily eligible in the base period to qualify for benefits, the Agency for Workforce Innovation must designate an alternative base period. As used in this subsection, the term "alternative base period" means the last four completed calendar quarters immediately preceding the first day of an individual's benefit year. If the agency is unable to access wage information through its mainframe database for determining monetary eligibility for benefits based on the individual's alternative base period, the agency may base the determination on an affidavit submitted by the individual attesting to his or her wages for those calendar quarters. The individual must also furnish payroll information, if available, in support of the affidavit. Benefits based on an alternative base period must be adjusted if the quarterly report of wage information received from the employer under s. 443.141 results
