The 18 19 insurance contract may not prohibit, and claims forms must provide an option for, the payment of benefits directly to a 20 21 licensed hospital, licensed ambulance provider, physician, or 22 dentist for care provided pursuant to s. 395.1041 or part III of 23 chapter 401. The insurer may require written attestation of assignment of benefits. Payment to the provider from the insurer 24 may not be more than the amount that the insurer would otherwise 25 26 have paid without the assignment. 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
