The Committee on Judiciary (Baker) recommended the following: Senate Amendment (with title amendment) 2 3 Delete lines 54 - 60 4 and insert: 5 (b) In addition to the authority granted in paragraph (a), 6 natural guardians, on behalf of any of their minor children, may 7 waive and release, in advance, any claim or cause of action that 8 would accrue to any of their minor children to the same extent 9 that an adult may do so on his or her own behalf. A waiver and 10 release authorized under this paragraph is disfavored and must

be strictly construed against a party claiming to be relieved of 11 liability due to the waiver and release. Such waiver and release 12

14	is stated clearly and unequivocally in the waiver and release,

16	know what he or she is contracting away. This paragraph does not
17	authorize a waiver and release for illegal acts.
