House Resolution

A resolution designating March 19, 2009, as "Deep Vein Thrombosis Awareness Day."

5 WHEREAS, deep vein thrombosis (DVT) is a common but serious 6 medical condition that occurs when a blood clot forms inside a 7 deep vein, usually in the lower limbs, leading to either 8 partially or completely blocked circulation, and

9 WHEREAS, approximately 2 million Americans are affected by 10 DVT each year and 600,000 of those are hospitalized for the 11 condition, and

12 WHEREAS, pulmonary embolism, a complication of DVT, may be 13 the most common, preventable cause of hospital death in the 14 United States, and up to 300,000 individuals who develop the 15 condition each year will die unnecessarily, more than the number 16 of Americans who die as a result of AIDS and breast cancer 17 combined, and

WHEREAS, symptoms of DVT may include pain, swelling and increased temperature, tenderness, and discoloration or redness of the affected area, yet as many as half of all DVT episodes produce minimal symptoms or symptoms that are completely silent, and

23 WHEREAS, national television correspondent David Bloom, who 24 reported for a Florida media station during Hurricane Andrew, 25 died of a pulmonary embolism while covering the war in Iraq, and 26 his widow, Melanie Bloom, and the more than 50 member 27 organizations of the Coalition to Prevent Deep Vein Thrombosis 28 are working to raise public awareness of this silent killer, and

29 WHEREAS, the declaration of March 19, 2009, as "Deep Vein 30 Thrombosis Awareness Day" in the State of Florida will honor the 31 memory of David Bloom, help the public understand that awareness 32 of the dangers of DVT and the preventability of the condition 33 are critical in reducing the risk of DVT, and draw attention to the fact that the education of health care professionals, 34 policymakers, and the public about the risk factors and 35 36 prevention measures associated with DVT will reduce the number 37 of individuals who die or become disabled because of this 38 condition and its life-threatening complications, NOW, 39 THEREFORE, 40 41 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of 42 Florida: 43 44 That the Florida House of Representatives designates March
