Senate Amendment

Delete line 177
and insert:
presumption of detriment to the child. Evidence that a parent has been convicted of a misdemeanor of the first degree involving domestic violence, as defined in s. 741.28 and chapter 775, or meets the criteria set forth in s. 39.806(1)(d), when a victim of the offense was a child or was the other parent or spouse, also creates a rebuttable presumption of detriment to the child. If the presumption is not
