House Resolution

A resolution in recognition of the Jupiter Christian School Eagles, 2008 Class 1B High School Football State Champions.

WHEREAS, on Friday, December 12, 2008, the Jupiter Christian School Eagles defeated South Daytona-Warner Christian in the Citrus Bowl stadium in Orlando by a score of 49-14 to win the 2008 Class 1B State High School Football Championship for the second consecutive year, and

WHEREAS, the championship win was the culmination of a 14-win regular season in which Jupiter Christian, under the guidance of Head Coach Bill Powers, dominated its opponents, winning by an average of 36 points per game, and was also the 27th consecutive win for the Eagles, which is the best consecutive high school football winning streak in the state, and
