WHEREAS, Quarterback A.J. Graham led the Amos P. Godby High School Cougars to the Class 3A Florida High School Athletic Association State Championship game, and

WHEREAS, during his spectacular 2008 season, A.J. Graham completed 244 of 396 passes for 3,870 yards and 38 touchdowns, rushed for 564 yards on 99 carries and scored 10 touchdowns, and in the process set school records for attempts, completions, passing yards, and touchdowns, and

Graham was named to the 2008 All Big Bend Team and the 2008 All State Team, was named the "Offensive Player of the Year" by the Tallahassee Democrat and the "Most Outstanding Player" by the Tallahassee Quarterback Club, and played in the Florida Athletic Coaches Association North-South Game, and

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2009, A.J. Graham became the first football player in the history of the City of Tallahassee to be presented the Florida Mr. Football Award, and
