9 WHEREAS, the United States' human space flight program is 10 scheduled to cease operations on September 30, 2010, and

WHEREAS, the cessation of our nation's human space flight program will result in the loss of employment of thousands of highly trained space flight employees in Florida, and

14 WHEREAS, Florida is home to thousands of suppliers and 15 service providers who will lose employment or vital income upon 16 cessation of the United States' human space flight program, and

WHEREAS, the next planned United States' human space flight program is not scheduled to be in operation for at least 5 years, and

20 WHEREAS, a gap of 5 years in human space flight programs 21 will result in our nation's loss of highly specialized space-22 faring skills due to the dispersion of the workforce, and

23 WHEREAS, both the United States and Florida have already 24 experienced economic devastation resulting from the abrupt 25 cessation of the Apollo Program and have learned from that 26 period of history, and

27 WHEREAS, other countries, some of which are hostile to the 28 United States, will have the opportunity during our nation's
