House Resolution

A resolution designating April 2009 as "Donate Life Month" in Florida.

WHEREAS, one of the most meaningful and generous gifts that a human being can bestow upon another is the gift of life, and

WHEREAS, a new patient is added to the national patient waiting list for an organ transplant every 10 minutes, and

WHEREAS, more than 101,000 Americans are currently on the national waiting list for organ transplantation, of whom nearly 3,700 are in Florida, and

WHEREAS, an average of 18 people die every day awaiting an organ transplant and approximately one million people could benefit from lifesaving tissue transplants each year, and

WHEREAS, Donate Life Florida is a nonprofit community service organization dedicated to empowering the public to save and enhance lives through organ and tissue donation, and

WHEREAS, the state supports Donate Life Florida's lifesaving mission, and

WHEREAS, in 1983 the United States Congress authorized and requested the President to issue a Proclamation designating a week in April as National Organ Donation Awareness Week and, in 1986, expanded the Proclamation to National Organ and Tissue Donation Awareness Week, and

WHEREAS, former United States Secretary of Health and Human Services Tommy Thompson declared April 2003 as National Donate Life Month, NOW, THEREFORE,
