23	(2) A health care provider shall inform the patient that
24	the HIV test is planned, provide information about the test, and
25	inform the patient that there are numerous treatment options
26	available for a patient who tests positive for the presence of
27	the antibody or antigen to the human immunodeficiency virus. The
28	health care provider shall also inform the patient that a person
29	who tests negative should continue to be routinely tested. The

30	health care provider shall advise the patient that he or she has
31	the right to decline the test. If the patient objects to
32	testing, a written statement of objection, signed by the
33	patient, shall be placed in the patient's medical record.

36	in this state and who, as part of his or her scope of practice,
37	performs physical examinations and orders, performs, or
