(a) Assist the victim in obtaining medical treatment if medical treatment is necessary as a result of the alleged incident.

- (b) Advise the victim that he or she may contact a certified rape crisis center from which the victim may receive services.
- (2) (a) The law enforcement officer shall give the victim immediate notice of the legal rights and remedies available to a victim on a standard form developed and distributed by the Department of Law Enforcement.
- (b) As necessary, the department shall revise the "Legal Rights and Remedies Notice to Victims" to include a general summary of s. 784.046 using simple English as well as Spanish. The department shall distribute the notice as a model form for sexual battery victims to be used by all law enforcement agencies throughout the state. The notice must include the resource listing, including telephone number, for the area certified rape crisis center as designated by the Department of Health.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
