 2 An act relating to citrus canker eradication; repealing s.
 3 581.1845, F.S., relating to the citrus canker eradication
 4 program and the payment of compensation to eligible
 5 homeowners whose citrus trees have been removed under the
 6 program; amending s. 215.22, F.S.; deleting an exemption
 7 from a service charge imposed on income of a revenue
 8 nature deposited in trust funds for funds held for the
 9 payment of citrus canker eradication and compensation to
 10 conform; amending s. 933.02, F.S.; deleting a cross-
 11 reference to conform; providing an effective date.

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 13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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 15 Section 1. Section 581.1845, Florida Statutes, is
 16 repealed.

17 Section 2. Paragraphs (i) through (w) of subsection (1) of
 18 section 215.22, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as paragraphs
 19 (h) through (v), respectively, and present paragraph (h) of that
 20 subsection is amended to read:

21 215.22 Certain income and certain trust funds exempt.—

22 (1) The following income of a revenue nature or the
 23 following trust funds shall be exempt from the appropriation
 24 required by s. 215.20(1):

27 Section 3. Paragraph (d) of subsection (4) of section
 28 933.02, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
