20	reactive drywall in improvements to real property, a property			
21	owner or a condominium association authorized under chapter 718			
22	to enter into contracts on behalf of unit owners, and a			
23	condominium developer or licensed contractor, or any combination			
24	of such persons or entities, may agree to specific measures to			
25	effect such repairs. If these measures are completed pursuant to			
26	the agreement, the condominium association, property owner,			
27	subsequent owners, and their successors in interest shall not
