10 (1) The Governor, Lieutenant Governor, members of the  
11 Cabinet, state legislators, ~~or~~ candidates for such offices, or  
12 affiliated party committees that ~~who~~ directly or indirectly  
13 solicit, cause to be solicited, or accept any contribution on  
14 behalf of an organization that is exempt from taxation under s.  
15 527 or s. 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code, which such  
16 individuals, in whole or in part, establish, maintain, or

17 control, shall file a statement with the division within 5 days  
18 after commencing such activity on behalf of the organization.

19 The statement shall contain the following information:

20 (a) The name of the person acting on behalf of the  
21 organization.

22 (b) The name and type of the organization.

23 (c) A description of the relationship between the person  
24 and the organization.

25 (2) Failure to timely file the statement shall subject the  
26 person to a civil penalty of \$50 per day for each late day,  
27 payable from the personal funds of the violator.

28 (3) Upon filing a statement with the division, an  
29 individual subject to the requirements of subsection (1) shall  
30 promptly create a public website that contains a mission  
31 statement and the names of persons associated with the  
32 organization. The address of the website shall be reported to  
33 the division within 5 business days after the website is  
34 created.

35 (4) All contributions received shall be disclosed on the  
36 website within 5 business days after deposit, together with the  
37 name, address, and occupation of the donor. All expenditures by  
38 the organization shall be individually disclosed on the website  
39 within 5 business days after being made.

40 (5) The filing requirements of subsection (1) do not apply  
41 to an individual acting on behalf of his or her own campaign or  
42 a political party of which the individual is a member.
