**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

Delete lines 251 - 274  
and insert:

(b) 1. On or before June 15 ~~July 1~~ of each year, the council on children's services shall prepare and submit to the governing body of the county a tentative annual written budget of the district's expected income and expenditures, including a contingency fund. The council shall, in addition, compute a proposed millage rate within the voter-approved cap necessary to fund the tentative budget ~~and, prior to adopting a final budget, comply with the provisions of s. 200.065, relating to the method~~

13 ~~of fixing millage, and shall fix the final millage rate by~~  
14 ~~resolution of the council.~~ The council shall include with the  
15 submission the council's rationale for the budget, as well as a  
16 detailed explanation for any significant changes in the proposed  
17 use of funds from the prior year's approved budget.

18 2.a. Within 20 days after receiving the tentative budget  
19 from the council, the governing body of the county shall hold a  
20 public hearing and receive public testimony on the tentative  
21 budget. At its next scheduled meeting after the public hearing,  
22 the governing body of the county shall approve the budget or  
23 reject it and direct the council to submit a revised tentative  
24 budget within 10 days for approval or rejection by the governing  
25 body at its next scheduled meeting. The council may not adopt a  
26 final budget until the budget has been approved by the governing  
27 body.
