14 Florida Historic Capitol and the Legislative Research Center and 15 Museum be made confidential and exempt from public-records 16 requirements if such donor or prospective donor desires to 17 remain anonymous. In order to encourage private support for 18 publicly owned performing arts centers and the direct-support 19 organization, it is a public necessity to promote the giving of gifts to, and the raising of private funds for, the acquisition, 20 renovation, rehabilitation, and operation of publicly owned 21 22 performing arts centers and the programming and preservation of 23 the Florida Historic Capitol and the Legislative Research Center and Museum. An essential element of an effective plan for 24 25 promoting the giving of private gifts and the raising of private 26 funds is the need to protect the identity of prospective and 27 actual donors who desire to remain anonymous. If the identity of prospective and actual donors who desire to remain anonymous is 28 29 subject to disclosure, there is a chilling effect on donations 30 because donors are concerned about disclosure of personal information leading to theft and, in particular, identity theft, 31 32 including personal safety and security. Therefore, the 33 Legislature finds that it is a public necessity to make 34 confidential and exempt from public-records requirements 35 information that would identify a donor or prospective donor of 36 a donation made for the benefit of a publicly owned performing 37 arts center or a donor or prospective donor to the direct-38 support organization for the Florida Historic Capitol and the 39 Legislative Research Center and Museum if such donor or 40 prospective donor wishes to remain anonymous.
