(2) A student who is enrolled in a program that terminates in an associate degree or a baccalaureate degree may receive an award for a maximum of 110 percent of the number of credit hours required to complete the program. A student who is enrolled in a program that terminates in a career certificate may receive an award for a maximum of 110 percent of the credit hours or clock hours required to complete the program up to 90 credit hours. However, for a student who is initially funded in the 2010-2011



academic term, the student may receive an award for a maximum of 100 percent of the number of credit hours required to complete an associate degree or a baccalaureate degree program, or the student may receive an award for a maximum of 100 percent of the credit hours or clock hours required to complete up to 90 credit hours of a program that terminates in a career certificate. A student who transfers from one of these program levels to another becomes eligible for the higher of the two credit hour limits.
