The Committee on Higher Education Appropriations (Thrasher) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete lines 799 - 808
and insert:

(2) A student who is enrolled in a program that terminates in an associate degree or a baccalaureate degree may receive an award for a maximum of 110 percent of the number of credit hours required to complete the program. A student who is enrolled in a program that terminates in a career certificate may receive an award for a maximum of 110 percent of the credit hours or clock hours required to complete the program up to 90 credit hours. However, for a student who is initially funded in the 2010-2011

13 academic term, the student may receive an award for a maximum of
14 100 percent of the number of credit hours required to complete
15 an associate degree or a baccalaureate degree program, or the
16 student may receive an award for a maximum of 100 percent of the
17 credit hours or clock hours required to complete up to 90 credit
18 hours of a program that terminates in a career certificate. A
19 student who transfers from one of these program levels to
20 another becomes eligible for the higher of the two credit hour
21 limits.
