4 Between lines 2138 and 2139, insert:

5 Section 64. The Legislature recognizes that due to varying  
6 local conditions, local governments have different planning  
7 needs that cannot be addressed by one uniform set of minimum  
8 planning criteria. Therefore, the state land planning agency may  
9 amend chapter 9J-5, Florida Administrative Code, to establish  
10 different minimum reporting criteria that are applicable to  
11 small or fiscally constrained local governments and, based upon  
12 the following factors, may establish a waiver provision to  
13 satisfy ongoing reporting requirements when no significant  
14 changes occur:

15 (1) Current and projected population.

16 (2) Size of the local jurisdiction.
